



Woman Driving Golf Cart Killed in Crash at Port Everglades

Police have identified the woman killed in a crash at Port Everglades Monday afternoon.

Broward Sheriff's Office said 40-year-old Luisa Anderson died after a golf cart she was driving collided with a mule truck.

The crash happened in the 4000 block of McIntosh Road at the port around 2:30 p.m.

Anderson was traveling through the Sun Terminals shipping container yard when the golf cart crashed into the truck in a four-way intersecting path.

Anderson was ejected from the golf cart and run over by the truck, police said. She was pronounced dead at the scene.

The driver of that truck was identified as 55-year-old Theoplous Wright. BSO detectives said the intersecting path where the crash happened does not have stop signs or traffic signals.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration was notified.
