

Valparaíso port worker dies after being hit by a crane

The incident occurred around 22.30 hours, forcing the entire third shift of workers to be dispatched.

An employee at the port of Valparaiso died during the night of this Friday after being struck by an RTG crane while doing his usual work.

The incident occurred at around 10:30 p.m., forcing the entire third shift of workers to be dispatched and work suspended at TPS site 5, 24 Hours reported.

The deceased was identified as Hernán Vedia López, who held his duties since 2009 and the company said in a statement that the records were placed at the disposal of the authorities to discover the causes of the tragic event.
