A Reminder About Distracted Driving



Because We Care About You and About Your Families

Unless the use of a cell phone is directly related to the operations being conducted, their use by <u>anyone</u> operating <u>any</u> vehicle is not permitted at our marine terminals.

When a cell phone (or any other personal electronic device) must be used; for any reason, the vehicle must be completely stopped in a designated area and taken out of gear.

The opportunities for serious accidents, accompanied by life-changing results, multiply greatly when vehicle operators are even mildly preoccupied by electronic distractions.

Don't allow a small electronic device that you pay a monthly bill for become and object responsible for claiming your life or the life of a fellow worker!
