
Marine Terminal Worker Fatally Injured at Latvian Bulk Cargo Facility

Liepaja Port - 22 November 2017




From European sources, Blueoceana Company is made to understand that a young marine terminal worker lost his life last Wednesday (22 November) in the midst of a coal handling operation at the Port of Liepaja, Latvia. The worker's employer has been identified as **Ekers Stividor**, **LP**.

Information coming to us, indicates that the as-yet unnamed worker had just concluded cleaning out a coal conveying wagon when, upon alighting to ground level, he was struck by a large Volvo front end loader. The twenty four year old worker's death was reportedly instantaneous.

The loader's direction of movement at the time is presently unknown to us. We understand, however, that the loader's operator has indicated that he simply did not see the worker in the moments leading up to the accident.
