



Fatal accident in the port of San Giorgio di Nogaro

Filt Cgil, Fit Cisl and Uiltrasporti have proclaimed for tomorrow a one-hour national strike in all Italian ports

Yesterday, an employee of a shipping agency lost his life at the port of San Giorgio di Nogaro, overwhelmed by a forklift truck. Following the umpteenth fatal accident in the port area, the national secretariats of Filt Cgil, Fit Cisl and Uiltrasporti have announced a one-hour national strike in all Italian ports that will take place tomorrow at the end of each shift. The trade unions have specified that the protest "will be held in accordance with local procedures and in compliance with the law and contractual provisions foreseen for the respective sectors of belonging".

"We express - added the three trade unions in a note - condolences and solidarity towards family members and colleagues of the deceased worker and at the same time, considering the long chain of fatal accidents that characterized this period, we will ask the Minister of Labor, Giuliano Poletti an urgent meeting to move from words to deeds in terms of safety at work, in particular regarding the risks of interference in the port area".
