Hurricane Season Begins



Each year at this time, the ILA~USMX Joint Safety Committee (JSC) customarily alerts workers, managers and employers in our industry about the importance of being alert and conscientious in adhering to the local port heavy weather/hurricane plans. Accordingly, we advise the following:

- 1. Get educated about the existence and content of heavy weather/hurricane plans
- 2. Closely adhere to those plans
- 3. Take no chances in protecting yourself and your facility

The United States Coast Guard publishes and regularly updates mandatory heavy weather/hurricane plans for each individual port sector. Several marine terminal operating firms maintain their own such plans, which should always complement those published by the Coast Guard.
