

A young docker hit by a truck in the port of Rosario died

The incident happened on Thursday, at about 2:30 pm in the sector of the South Dock "Silo Sur". The victim was identified as Danisa Gabriela Ortega, 24 years old.

A young 24-year-old **longshoreman** died Friday due to polytrauma after being hit by a truck while performing tasks at Terminal Puerto Rosario (TPR).

The incident had been recorded on Thursday afternoon in the sector of the South Galopon Dock "Silo Sur" of the TPR, newspaper El Ciudadano of that city in the southern province reported.

The victim served as a docker in the port of Rosario, when, because they are under investigation, the large vehicle reversed and ended up crushing the young woman against a lifting machine, which caused serious injuries.

This is Danisa Gabriela Ortega, who after the incident was transferred to the Mapaci Sanatorium, where she died around 9:30 p.m.

The guilty homicide prosecutor, Mariana Prunotto, who ordered an autopsy and required the intervention of the Prefecture to analyze the place where the incident occurred, works in the case.

In addition, the intervention of the Ministry of Labor of the province was requested to request reports on the working conditions in which the victim worked.
