



Wood load falls on worker in Itajai Port

On Monday morning (2), around 11am, the port worker Celso Klock had a serious accident while in one of the warehouses of the port of Itajaí. He and one other colleague transhipped a wooden cargo from a dry cargo container to a frozen cargo container.

By placing the load into the other and lifting it, the forklift had difficulty climbing the ramp. With that, the load shook too much and fell on the worker. It is estimated that the weight of the cargo was two tons. Celso remains hospitalized in the ICU of the Marieta Hospital in a very serious condition. According to information, he suffered a skull fracture and is in an induced coma.

The management of the Itajaí Housekeeping Union says that APM Terminals exposes the dockers to poor working conditions and that it does not even have first responders and ambulance in the port environment.
