

Worker suffers accident in the port of Itajaí and is ill in the ICU

Still in a coma, in the ICU of Marieta Konder Bornhasen Hospital, Itajaí, the port Celso Klock, 51 years.

He suffered a head injury Monday morning after a pile of wood fell on him.

The management of the Itajaí Housekeeping Union says that APM Terminals exposes the dockers to poor working conditions and that it does not even have first responders and ambulance in the port environment.

Celso rescued the firemen from Itajaí, because the company hired by APM, which is from Balneário Camboriú, would not have arrived on time.

APM said it will not comment on the accident because it has not heard all involved. It also confirmed that it no longer has rescuers and ambulances in the port and has an agreement with Unimed.
