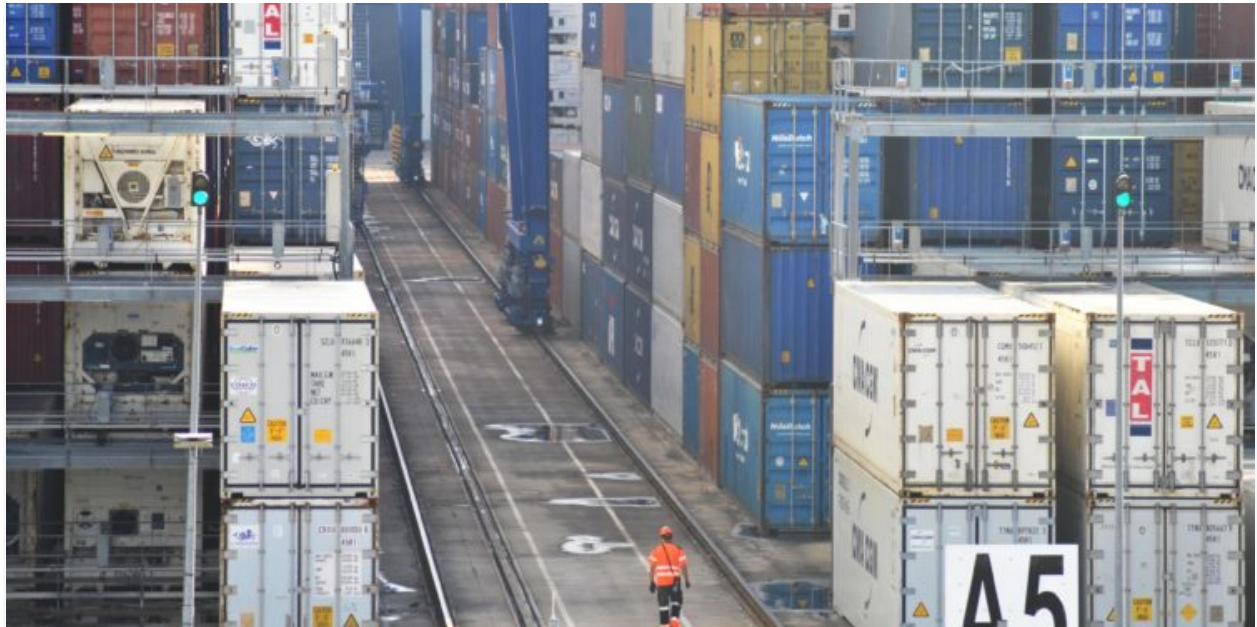




## A docker dies in the TTIA terminal

The worker has suffered a cardiorespiratory arrest

A docker has died, this Wednesday, at the TTIA container terminal in the port of Algiers. Apparently, according to the first information, the 46-year-old worker has lost his life as a result of a cardiorespiratory arrest, while performing his duties as an on-board pawn, in one of the afternoon hands (from 2 pm to 8 pm) in the Korean company facilities.

A medical team was moved to the place that was responsible for its transfer by ambulance, to the Hospital Punta Europa de Algiers where, apparently, a corpse was entered, since nothing could be done to save the life of the docker, despite trying his Resuscitation for a few minutes.

As a result of the worker's death, the two terminals of the port of Algiers (APM Terminals and Total Terminal International Algiers) have stopped the activity until the 2:00 pm shift on Thursday.
