A docker from the Port of Algeciras dies while working at TTI

The Port Employment Center worker was 48 years old and his resuscitation was not possible

A **docker** from the [Port of Algeciras](#) has died on Wednesday as a result of a cardiorespiratory arrest caused by a **heart attack** . The worker was in his turn of activity in the container terminal of **TTI Algeciras** when he suffered a **cardiac arrest** , as sources from the Port Employment Center have explained to *Southern Europe* .

To the place was moved a provision of toilets that moved the worker, **48** , to the **Hospital Punta de Europa** , although he died without his resuscitation being possible.

The **Port Center** , in turn, has sent an email to the entire workforce (more than 2,100 people between permanent staff and the eventual bag) in which it

confirmed the event and transferred its condolences to the family and the rest of the workers of the stowage

After the death was known, the two container terminals have **stopped their activity** during the afternoon and evening shifts (from 2:00 p.m.) and with the forecast to resume it at 2:00 on Thursday.
