

One worker dies between cargoes leaning on a cargo ship Nagoya Port

On the morning of the 3rd, a cargo ship was tilted at Nagoya Port, and two men who were working were caught between collapsed concrete plates, a 24-year-old man died. The firefighter is rescuing that another man is also injured.



At 8:30 a.m. on March 3, at the Yatomi Wharf in Nagoya Port in Yatomi City, Aichi Prefecture, a firefighter was informed that cargo aboard ship had collapsed and a man was pinched.

According to the Nagoya Coast Guard, a 498-ton cargo ship "Daiichi Tenshomaru" is tilted by about 30 degrees, and two men are sandwiched between collapsed concrete plates, of which a 24-year-old man Death was confirmed at the site.

Another firefighter is rescuing that another man in his 30s is also injured.

According to the Japan Coast Guard, the work was being carried out to unload the concrete plates at the time, and the Coast Guard was examining the situation in detail as it suddenly collapsed when trying to carry it out.
