


Worker dies in tragic accident in the port area of Veracruz

A worker who was driving a tractor truck during the early hours of Tuesday in the port area, died tragically after falling into the sea while maneuvering in one of the docks. According to the information gathered, the victim was completing his workday aboard a tractor truck, with which he fell into the water and was trapped in the cabin after diving approximately 18 meters.

The colleagues of the workers who witnessed the accident, pointed out that it was the heavy business name unit of the International Company of Associated Containers of Veracruz (ICAVE).

The operator of said unit was identified as 46-year-old Rogelio "N", who was manning the tractor-trailer in the direction of the dock, where he traveled 200 meters and apparently, due to a fault, hit an object and fell into the water.

Immediately, the emergency protocol was activated within the port area, so the rescue corporations together with the Secretary of the Navy moved to the area of the accident.

Despite their efforts, rescuers rescued the driver of the already lifeless unit, so the staff of the Comprehensive Law Enforcement Subunit were notified to remove his body. The maneuvers lasted a few hours more within the same port area, where a loading crane was the one that managed to hook the tractor and remove it from the water to remove it to the corresponding corralón.
