

Argentina: Operator dies in a work accident at the Port of Timbúes

An operator from the Puerto General San Martín stevedoring cooperative died while carrying out his duties at the **Dreyfus International Terminal** located in the town of **Timbúes** . The firm suspended activities and began an investigation to determine the cause of the accident.

According to what was reported by **Rosario 3**, based on the first information about the accident, the operator was moving loads in one of the warehouses when he was buried by a mountain of flour.

As a result of the above, the company's emergency teams together with firefighters and health authorities immediately activated a rescue protocol, finding the port worker dead.

“From the company we express our pain and deepest compassion to the collaborator's family and his colleagues at the Cooperative at this painful moment,” said **Luis Zubizarreta, regional director of Institutional Relations at Dreyfus** .

“Louis Dreyfus Company regrets the death of a collaborator at the Timbúes plant,” the firm expressed in a statement in which they specified that he works for the Cooperativa de Trabajos Portuarios Ltda. de San Martín , which provides outsourced services to its Timbúes plant.
