


Port worker dies after being run over by a forklift in Serra

A port worker, identified as Sebastião Freitas, died after being run over by a forklift at the Steel Products Terminal (TPS) of the Port of Praia Mole, which is located in Parque Industrial, in <u>Serra</u>. The accident happened in the early hours of Friday (27), and other details were not disclosed.

According to the Casual Port Work Labor Management Body of the State of Espírito Santo (OGMO-ES), the victim's contractor, immediate assistance was provided and the causes of the accident are under investigation by the Port Work Accident Prevention Commission (CPATP) and the Specialized Service in Port Work Safety and Health (SESSTP). The agency also stated that it is working together with the competent authorities to investigate the facts.

"OGMO-ES regrets to inform the death of the casual port worker that occurred on this date at the Steel Products Terminal (TPS) and sympathizes at this time with family and

friends, extending the most sincere condolences to all categories of workers and to port operators in Espírito Santo", he said in a note.

The Union of Inspectors – professionals responsible for counting and identifying goods on board a ship – mourned the death of the worker. He also informed that the wake is scheduled for this Saturday (28), at the Santo Antônio Cemetery, in <u>Vitória</u>.



The <u>Civil Police</u> reported that the case remains under investigation by the Specialized Office of Accidents at Work (Deat).
