

Machine operator's body is found by catraieiros

The corpse was recognized by a brother of the victim

The body of Renan da Silva Lobato, 30 years old, was found on the night of this Friday, the 19th, close to the place where he fell four days ago with a forklift, in Docas de Santana.

The information was confirmed by the Fire Department commander, Colonel Alexandre Veríssimo, to the **Diário do Amapá team**

Now the body of the worker, who was recognized by the victim's brother, will be handed over to the Scientific Police, so that standard procedures can be adopted, and later released to the family.

Renan had disappeared last Tuesday afternoon, the 16th, when he was on a forklift, transporting boxes of soybean oil to a foreign ship, both docked at the port. He fell with the vehicle into the river. The circumstances of the accident have not yet been disclosed.

The information was that Renan was wearing the machine's seat belt when the accident occurred and could have been trapped. However, on Thursday, the 18th, the forklift was lifted and he was not found.

The search work was intensified with a task force that involved Santana City Hall; the Fire Department; the Military, Civil and Federal police; the Brazilian Navy; the Brazilian Army; the Catraieiros Association and volunteers.

Drones, Jet Skis and even the Tactical Air Group (GTA) helped in the searches.
