Pasaia: A hundred colleagues of the security guard who died last Friday demand more inspections

Colleagues of the security guard who died on January 26 in the **port of Pasaia** and other port employees have gathered this Wednesday in front of one of the entrances to the infrastructure to protest this fatal work accident and **demand more inspections** and controls by **the authorities**.

Around a hundred **people** have participated in the **mobilization**, which had been called by the company committee of **Sabico Seguridad**, the company where the security guard who lost his life last Friday night when he was run over by a truck during the maneuver of **loading merchandise onto a ship**.

The rally was **held** starting at noon in front of the access to the port area from La Herrera, in the **Pasaia district of Trintxerpe**, with a banner with the motto in **Spanish** and **Basque** "Precariousness kills. **More inspection**. No more work accidents."

The protest, in addition to delegates from the **UGT**, **ELA and USO** committee , was also attended by **Sabico** security guards from other **workplaces** and stevedoring and unloading operators from the port of Gipuzkoa, as well as employees from several companies that operate in the **infrastructure**.

After the concentration, which passed **in** silence for half an hour, the head of the private security sector at **UGT**, **Isidro Campo**, once again insisted on the demand that an "exhaustive investigation" be carried out into the past accident. Friday in which the security guard, a 47-year - old **man from Gipuzkoa, died.**

"We demand that what happened be thoroughly investigated because it is clear that something went wrong," **Campo** told EFE, after which he asked that "responsibilities be cleared up, above all, so that it does not **happen again**."
