


Worker dead in Cagliari port, crushed between two containers

An investigation has been opened and an autopsy has been ordered on the body of the 50-year-old





Raffaele Massa, the 50-year-old worker from Quartucciu who died this morning while working on board a ship flying the Finnish flag chartered by the Grendi Group and moored at the Canal Port of Cagliari, was crushed between two containers that were being moved with semi-trailers.

This is what emerges from the first checks carried out on board the vessel. Prosecutor Daniele Caria, who coordinates the investigations conducted by the police, but also by the Spresal staff of the ASL and the Captaincy, is now waiting for the reports to understand precisely what happened on the cargo.

The worker was part of a team that was busy arranging containers and was crushed while moving the material. The first to raise the alarm were the colleagues who were with him. The 118 doctors and the police arrived on the scene, but there was nothing left to do for Raffaele Massa: the 50-year-old died instantly. Having opened an investigation, the prosecutor ordered an autopsy to be carried out.
