

Worker dead in the port of Cagliari, 72-hour strike by port workers

Port workers on strike for 72 hours after the death of **Raffaele Massa**, the **50-year-old worker** from Quartucciu who was **crushed** this morning by the trailer of the machinery used to handle containers, on board the Estraden cargo ship, chartered by the Grendi Group. This was decided jointly by the representatives of **CGIL, CISL and UIL**, who this morning went to the Porto Canale of Cagliari, where the accident occurred.

The abstention from work will begin **at midnight and end on Monday at 11.59pm**. On Monday morning, **January 29**, a **workers' meeting** was also organized at 12 in front of the headquarters of the Mare di Sardegna Port Authority.
